

We are greatly blessed to have Father George Parsenios lead the sessions at this annual Lenten retreat. Fr. George is Professor of New Testament at the Holy Cross Greek Orthodox School of Theology in Brookline, MA, where he has also served as Academic Dean. Before coming to Holy Cross, he was for 20 years a Professor of New Testament at Princeton Theological Seminary. He holds the MDiv degree from Holy Cross and a PhD in New Testament from Yale University. His research and writing focus on the interaction of early Christianity with classical literature, and he has written three books and several essays on New Testament themes. He is currently translating the Catechetical Homilies of Saint John Chrysostom and serves as the pastor of St. Nicholas Greek Orthodox Church in Lexington, MA. He and Presvytera Maureen have three children.
